




# SAY NO TO THE #SAUDI ARMS DEAL END THE WAR • FUND HUMAN NEEDS

We are the 58 per cent of Canadians who say it's more important to respect human rights than to sell weapons to countries like Saudi Arabia.

The \$15-billion Saudi arms deal is the largest military export contract in Canadian history. It was negotiated by the Canadian government to sell light armoured vehicles made at a Canadian branch plant of U.S.-based General Dynamics, the world's fifth biggest weapons corporation.

Saudi Arabia brutally represses political dissidents with floggings, crucifixions and beheadings. Women are imprisoned for driving. Unions are banned. Now, new video shows military light armoured vehicles being used by Saudi military to suppress religious minorities.

Join others to send a message to **Defence Minister Harjit Sajjan**, while he delivers a major speech to weapons producers, Canadian officials, and foreign military delegates inside the CANSEC arms show at 8:30 a.m.
